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Bill Analysis

SB 574 directs the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to establish a health information exchange certification with input from stakeholders. Certification shall be required for a health information exchange organization to qualify as an Oklahoma Statewide Health Information Exchange (OKHIE). Until such time as the health information exchange certification is established by OHCA, an OKHIE shall mean either Oklahoma State Health Information Network and Exchange (OKSHINE) or a health information exchange organization that was previously certified by the Oklahoma Health Information Exchange Trust. OKSHINE is a unit of the Oklahoma Health Care Authority charged with facilitating the exchange of health information to and from authorized individuals and healthcare organizations. Individuals and entities using the system shall not be held liable in any action for damages or costs of any nature that result solely from the person's use or failure to use OKSHINE information or data. The measure also specifies that users providing data to the network shall retain the ownership rights of such information. Additionally, the measure repeals provisions of law relating to the study of creating such a network.

House Amendments

HA's to the measure adds language to the measure relating to the establishment of a health information exchange certification with input from stakeholders.

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
