**Bill Analysis**

SB 60 creates “Bobbi White Act of 2021.” The measure will prohibit drivers from using a handheld electronic communications device while piloting a vehicle in motion in a school zone during normal school hours. SB 60 does allow the use of such a device if it does not require hands to use. Additionally, it amends the definition of an “electronic communications device” to include the ability to manually search the Internet.
