**Bill Analysis**

SB 638 provides for residential care homes to donate unused prescription drugs to a charitable clinic. Additionally, such facilities may return unused prescriptions to pharmacies. If the pharmacy accepts a return of unused prescription medications that were purchased by the state Medicaid program, the pharmacy shall credit or reimburse the state Medicaid program for the medications. Pharmacies may refuse to accept returned, unused prescriptions. Pharmacies are authorized to redistribute the returned medications.
