**Bill Analysis**

SB 642 modifies language related to the statewide system of student assessments. It removes language regarding optional administration of a nationally recognized college- and career-readiness assessment and replaces it with language allowing administration of a multiple-aptitude battery that measures developed abilities and helps predict future academic and occupational success in the military beginning in the 2021-22 school year.
