## **Bill Analysis**

SB 661 requires students beginning in the 2022-23 school year to take and pass the U.S. citizenship test in order to graduate from an accredited high school. It directs school districts to administer the test to eleventh and twelfth graders and provide those who do not score at least a 60 percent the opportunity to retake the test as many times as necessary. It provides accommodations for students on an individualized education program and students identified as English language learners.
