**Bill Analysis**

SB 67 allows the State Board of Education to grant an exception to the requirements for certification examinations for teacher candidates who are deaf. It allows the Board to grant such an exception upon certain criteria being met. It allows those granted such exceptions to teach in American Sign Language immersion programs, the Oklahoma School for the Deaf, programs for the deaf or other classroom settings where American Sign Language is used as the language of instruction.
