**Bill Analysis**

SB 703 modifies how out-of-state and out-of-country teaching experience is calculated as it pertains to the minimum salary schedule. The measure directs that a teacher be granted credit, for purposes of state salary increments, for all years of out-of-state teaching experience and out-of-country teaching experience at primary and secondary schools operated by the U.S. Department of Defense or that are affiliated with the U.S. Department of State beginning with the 2021-22 school year.
