**Bill Analysis**

SB 742 authorizes the Office of Juvenile Affairs to contract with other state agencies, tribal governments, or the federal government to allow for the placement of children or young adults in the custody of a state agency to reside and participate in any identified contracted or operated program or facility. Contracts with tribal governments or the federal government shall be subject to the approval of the Attorney General.
