Bill Analysis

SB 756 provides for private certification companies to voluntarily participate and register with the government. Such companies must meet certain requirements outlined in the measure to register with the government. Individuals certified by a registered certification company shall be authorized to engage in the lawful occupation for which that individual is privately certified. Additionally, every individual practicing a licensed occupation in the state shall be required to prominently display their licensing or certifying authority. Individuals falsely claiming to be privately certified shall be subject to penalties provided for in the state's deceptive trade practices act. Any private certification company that does not meet the requirements outlined in the measure that continues to meet 90 days after failing to meet these requirements shall also be subject to penalties provided for in the state's deceptive trade practices act.
