**Bill Analysis**

The CS for SB 811 requires all law enforcement agencies to have 25% of all employed officers certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training to be trained in crisis escalation offered by the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services no later than November 1, 2024. CLEET shall be required to offer at least 4 hours of crisis escalation training to officers in its training course. Of the 8 hours law enforcement officers must complete as part of their continuing education, 1 must be in crisis escalation training.
