Bill Analysis

The FS for SB 835 designates Central Daylight Time as the standard time for Oklahoma. The measure provides that the adoption of daylight-saving time may be changed by future legislative action and that it shall only take effect if the United States Congress amends federal law that permits states to enter upon and permanently observe daylight saving time. The measure also clarifies that it shall not be construed to affect the standard time established by United States law governing the movements of common carriers engaged in interstate commerce or affect performance of an act by an officer or department of the United States.
