Bill Analysis

SB 841 provides that the holder of an Oklahoma Retail Beer or Retail Wine License who was licensed and permitted to sell low-point beer for off-premises consumption until the passage of State Question 792 shall not be prohibited from holding an ownership interest in a manufacturer whose products are made outside of the state. This right shall only apply to the ownership interests in the manufacturer that were held by the Oklahoma licensed retailer, or its successor in interest, as of November 8, 2016. The measure prohibits the manufacturer from selling any wine or spirits that are made by the commonly owned manufacturer at its retail locations.

CCR Changes

The Conference Committee Report for SB 841 provides that the holder of an Oklahoma Retail Beer or Retail Wine License who was licensed and permitted to sell low-point beer for off-premises consumption until the passage of State Question 792 shall not be prohibited from holding an ownership interest in a manufacturer whose products are made outside of the state. Engrossed language applied to manufacturers of alcoholic beverages that own more than 15% of the stock of a retail licensee.
