**Bill Analysis**

The FS for SB 858 provides for law enforcement agencies to request the county clerk or county treasurer to keep law enforcement personal records off the Internet and to secure such records in the county clerk's office. Law enforcement officials making such a request must obtain an order of a court that requires the county clerk, county election board, or county treasurer to maintain the personal information of the person or entity in a confidential manner and sign a sworn affidavit that the person in question is an officer.
