Bill Analysis

The CS for SB 881 increases the maximum fine for any person failing to comply with the orders of the State Fire Marshal or their deputies from \$50.00 to \$1,000.00 and the daily penalty from \$10.00 to \$100.00. The measure provides the person or entity fined with the right to a hearing provided the request for a hearing is submitted to the State Fire Marshal within 10 days of the fine's issuance. The appeal shall be heard by an Administrative Hearing Officer. The Officer may then issue a proposed order containing proposed findings of fact and conclusion of law. The State Fire Marshal may deny or approve the findings at his or her discretion. Any party aggrieved by the final order of the State Fire Marshal Commission may appeal to the district court of the county
