**Bill Analysis**

The CS for SB 9 modifies “obscene material” by removing “an average person applying contemporary community standards” and replacing it with “reasonable person” as it relates to how the court would determine what constitutes obscene material. The measure provides that these standards shall not apply if a person knowingly providing obscene materials to a minor.
