Bill Analysis

SB 924 provides that while the state is the owner of state data, defined as all data files hosted, procured, owned, processed, secured, stored, or created by this state or its state agencies, individual state agencies shall comply with their respective statutory obligations in managing state data including responding to open records requests, reporting and responding to data breaches, and any other statutory obligations required when hosting, accessing, storing, collecting, or processing state data. The measure authorizes the Chief Information Officer to establish standards and criteria for sharing state data between state agencies.

CCR Changes

The Conference Committee Report for SB 924 completely substitutes engrossed language with the language described above.
