Bill Analysis

SB 927 provides that no state of emergency may last longer than 2 weeks unless a majority of the affected municipality's council votes to request the Governor for an extension or if the Legislature votes to request an extension for a state-wide emergency. The measure also removes the power of the Governor to prohibit a designated number of persons from gathering, the sale of alcoholic beverages, and other reasonable activities the Governor deems fit. Additionally, the measure modifies disorderly conduct by specifying that such conduct shall apply to those who recklessly create a public risk or make an unreasonable noise after being asked to stop,
