**Bill Analysis**

SB 96 authorizes a patient to access information pertaining to his or her medical bills. The measure also increases the fee charged to attorneys, insurance companies, and records accessed via subpoena from \$10.00 to \$20.00. The base fee for each printed x-ray or other photograph fee is also increased from \$5.00 to \$15.00. Images provided in an electronic format are subject to a fee of \$20.00 per CD/DVD or other electronic media. Additionally, the measure requires the base fee to be charged regardless of whether any records related to the request are located. An additional \$15.00 fee is created by the measure for requests to provide a certification or an affidavit by the provider regarding the authenticity of the medical records or bills.

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
