Bill Analysis

SB 970 provides that any portion of any document or information provided to an agency or entity of the state or a political subdivision to obtain licensure that contains an applicant's personal address, personal phone number, personal electronic mail address or other contact information shall not be considered a “record” as it applies to the Oklahoma Open Records Act. Lists of persons licensed, the existence of a license of a person, or a business or commercial address, or other business or commercial information disclosable under state law submitted with an application for licensure shall be considered public record.

House Amendments

HA’s to the measure modifies language relating to information that shall be considered as a public record and provides that contact information shall not be considered a “record” as it applies to the Oklahoma Open Records Act. HA’s also specify that lists of persons licensed, business and commercial information, as well as the existence of a license of a person shall be considered a record.
