Bill Analysis

SB 970 provides that any information provided to a state agency or entity that will be utilized to provide a license or certificate to an individual shall not be considered a “record” as it applies to the Oklahoma Open Records Act. The measure authorizes public bodies keeping such information to release the records at their discretion, provided, identifying information relating to the occupants of any residential structure and email addresses shall be redacted in addition to other personal identifiers required to be redacted by current law.
