Bill Analysis

SB 99 specifies the allowable time period for the initial court appearance of persons charged with domestic abuse, domestic assault and battery or domestic assault, or battery with a deadly weapon to no earlier than 24 hours after arrest and no later than 72 hours after arrest. This requirement shall not be construed to constitute an unnecessary delay unless the person arrested can establish prejudice by reason of the delay.
