Bill Analysis

SB 992 specifies that information provided to a state agency for the purpose of the agency utilizing such information to provide a license or certificate to an individual shall not be considered a “record” as it relates to the Open Records Act. The measure provides that the license or certificate shall remain public record. The measure also directs public bodies to redact personal email addresses from published records as well as any portion of any record that contains the name or any other identifier of the occupants of any residential structure.
