Bill Analysis

SJR 15 submits to the people a proposed constitutional amendment to prohibit institutions within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education from requiring students to enroll in a course that is not a core requirement of their chosen curriculum, a course for which there is no tuition or fee charged comparable to similar courses, or a course that is not directly relevant to the degree being pursued and that the student or financially responsible person objects to on philosophical or religious reasons. The measure prohibits such students from being penalized academically or financially.
