Bill Analysis

SJR 19 submits to the people a constitutional amendment prescribing the time and manner in which a person may request an absentee ballot. A person may only request an absentee ballot only if an occupation or business of the elector requires him or her to be elsewhere, illness or disability physically incapacitates the elector, observing a religious holiday, or the voter has election day duties and is a county employee.
