Bill Analysis

SJR 25 calls for a Constitutional Convention of the States for the purpose of proposing an amendment to the U.S. Constitution that would require every state to institute voting standards that require proof of identification, restricting the vote to citizens of the United States, notarized absentee ballots, and a prohibition on persons other than the voter the ballot is addressed to from handling or marking absentee ballots. The amendment also provides violators of these provisions shall be guilty of a felony and shall receive a term of imprisonment not less than 5 years. Such persons shall also be prohibited from voting for life.
