**Bill Analysis**

SJR 50 approves the outlined rules promulgated by state agencies listed below:

- 1) Oklahoma Department of Commerce- Newly proposed rules to the Oklahoma Remote Quality Jobs Incentive Act
- 2) Oklahoma Board of Nursing- Amendments to requirements for registration and licensure as a Registered Nurse and Licensed Practical Nurse
- 3) Banking Department- Amendments to rules governing Department requirements for bank branches, delivery of documents, procedural rules, and an Internal Control Program
- 4) Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners- Amendments to rules relating to the Oklahoma Veterinary Practice Act
- 5) Oklahoma Horseracing Commission- Amendments to the rules relating to the Oklahoma Horse Racing Act
- 6) Oklahoma Funeral Board- Amendments to procedures relating to requests for interpretation of rules
- 7) Grand River Dam Authority- Amendments to rules governing scenic rivers
- 8) Oklahoma Aeronautic Commission- Amendments to rules governing the grant program for airport construction
- 9) Oklahoma Employment Security Commission-
- 10) Department of Environmental Quality- Amendments to rules governing source obligations
- 11) Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services- Amendments to rules relating to fees for Certified Problem Gambling Treatment Counselors
- 12) Board of Tests for Alcohol and Drug Influence- Amendments to rules relating to approval for use of certain equipment in tests
- 13) Department of Wildlife Conservation- Amendments to rules governing hunting licenses, fees, and duration of licenses
- 14) District Attorneys Council- Amendments to rules governing eligibility criteria for compensation as it relates to crime victims
- 15) Secretary of State- Amendments to rules governing administrative operations, administrative rules on rulemaking, and the central filing system for agricultural liens
- 16) Department of Mines- Amendments to rules governing the Commission, non-coal rules and regulations, the Coal Reclamation Act of 1979, and explosive/blasting regulations
- 17) Insurance Department- Amendments to rules relating the administrative operations of the Department, life and health insurance, property and casualty insurance, and other licensees
- 18) Workers' Compensation Commission- Amendments to rules governing requests for agency public information as well as practices and procedures of the Commission
