Fiscal Analysis

HB 1024 prohibits those convicted of certain crimes from applying for or obtaining a license to serve process in Oklahoma. It creates a misdemeanor for serving process without a license, and for assaulting a process server while in the performance of their duties. It also provides penalties for resisting the execution of a legal process, and releasing or failing to control an animal at the time a legal process is being executed. The fiscal impact of this bill is contingent upon the number of convictions of the offenses listed in the bill.
