Fiscal Analysis

HB 1783 give the Oklahoma State Athletic Commission jurisdiction over amateur kickboxers and amateur kickboxing events. Officials at the Oklahoma State Athletic Commission anticipate that the measure will have a small fiscal impact to the Commission. Based on historical data two to three amateur kickboxing events may be promoted a year. Revenues from the events would come from promoter licenses (\$250), event permits (\$150), participant licenses (\$2,160), coaches' licenses (\$3,600) and attendance related revenue (\$1,350) totaling \$7,510. Costs to the Commission would include lead inspectors (\$1,513.20) and five inspectors (\$3,033) totaling \$4,546.20.

Full Year Impact: Approximately \$3,000 to Athletic Commission
