Fiscal Analysis

HB 2214 directs the Department of Wildlife Conservation to establish licenses for hunting, fishing, transporting, exporting and breeding wildlife on or from the Department's land as opposed to licenses and fee schedules being defined in statute. HB2214 also doubles the minimum fines for those caught hunting or fishing without a license. The department believes that any hunting and fishing license fee changes will be revenue neutral and not have a fiscal impact. The increased fines will bring in approximately \$2,650.00 to the department.
