**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 2544 amends the list of offenses for which a person must serve 85% of their sentence prior to becoming eligible for parole as it relates to abuse of a vulnerable adult. Previous language was limited to abuse of vulnerable adults who reside in a nursing home. This bill removes that specific language to include all vulnerable adults as defined in statute. It also amends the language for this offense under the violent crimes statute to match. The fiscal impact of this bill is contingent on the number of convictions and terms of imprisonment for this offense.
