**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3005 creates a new felony related to stolen automotive catalytic converters. Creating a new felony may increase the prison population in the state which could also result in higher incarceration costs for the Department of Corrections. Whether these costs increase to an extent that require additional appropriations will depend on the number of arrests and convictions for the offense.
