**PROPOSAL:** Amendatory 47 O.S. § 1151

The measure proposes to amend 47 O.S. § 1151 to clarify statutory language by providing that no citation for operating a vehicle without proper license plate/decal or on which all taxes due the state have not been paid may be issued by any state, county or municipal law enforcement officer during the month immediately succeeding the last day of the month during which a vehicle registration should have been renewed and a current license plate decal obtained and displayed on the license plate of the vehicle. Under current law this citation prohibition is effective during the thirty-day period immediately succeeding the last day of the registration expiration month.
