Fiscal Analysis

HB 4195 directs the State Board of Education and the State Regents for Higher Education to allow concurrent enrollment of students in grades 9-12. It states that subject to senior and junior concurrent enrollment being fully funded, each freshman and sophomore is entitled to a max of 6 credit hours each year, subject to funding.

FY 22 base allocation for concurrent waivers is \$13,516,350.00 and the Oklahoma State Regents of Higher Education is requesting an additional \$4 million for FY 23 to fully fund juniors.
