**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 110 increases the maximum term of imprisonment and the maximum fine for persons convicted of assault and battery with intent to cause great bodily harm by strangulation or attempted strangulation against an intimate partner or family/household member. This bill could result in an increase in Oklahoma's incarcerated population, however the fiscal impact is contingent on the number of people convicted of the offenses listed in the bill. Average daily cost per inmate for maximum, medium, and minimum security is \$108.17, \$61.71, and \$57.39 respectively.
