**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 1107 provides qualifying offenders with a REAL ID Noncompliant driver license prior to discharge, valid for 180-days. Authorizes DPS to issue provisional licenses under the condition that the license holder pays a minimum of \$5.00 per month for the purposes of satisfying outstanding fees and fines.

The fiscal impact of SB1107 is indeterminable as it is contingent upon variables that cannot currently be quantified. Including but not limited to, the number of offenders who are eligible for a DL extension upon release and individual payment plans for outstanding fees and fines.
