Fiscal Analysis

SB 128 creates the Seizure Safe Schools Act. It requires each school district with a student who has a seizure disorder beginning January 1, 2022, to have at least 1 employee who has training to administer or assist with self-administration of seizure medication and recognize symptoms of seizures and take steps to respond. CDC and the Epilepsy Foundation of America offer free training and educational programs to school staff and students. But schools may incur costs for any additional training they may choose to offer. There is likely to be costs for travel, facility rental, resources and materials. Based on similar trainings done in the past, OSDE estimates the cost to be a minimum of \$100 per day training fee plus travel, training materials and facility rental, if applicable.
