**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 1386 requires public high schools to make a family and consumer science course or equivalent course available to students subject to availability of funding and teaching staff. It specifies areas of instruction to be included at a minimum and allows for on-site or virtual instruction of the course. School districts are likely to incur costs for teaching staff and/or online course.
