## **Fiscal Analysis**

SB 1429 allows an individual seeking alternative teacher certification to pass the general education portion of the required competency exam or have a master's degree from an accredited institution. It also states that a teacher candidate or a teacher with a master's degree from such an institution who is seeking traditional teacher certification is exempt from having to pass the general education portion of the competency exam. It is estimated that 5-10% of OGET test takers have a master's degree. Last school year OEQA administered 3,986 OGETs. OEQA is reimbursed \$10 per test.
