**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 1623 creates the Learn Everywhere Act, allowing students attending a public school district or public charter school to be eligible for extended learning opportunities outside of the traditional classroom. It allows a student to request credit for an extended learning opportunity. It requires each school district board of education and charter school governing body to adopt an extended learning opportunity policy.

To implement the provisions of this bill, including evaluation of the extended learning opportunities and master of coursework by students and to provide technical assistance to school districts and public charter schools, OSDE expects to incur personnel cost.

Personnel cost (recurring) - .25 - .5 FTE at \$60,000 plus benefits - \$23,500-\$47,000. School districts may also incur a cost if there is a need to hire additional staff to implement the bill but it is hard to determine at this time.
