**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 1650 directs school district boards of education that have adopted a policy for drug testing school employees for certain controlled substances to include in the policy a provision requiring the dismissal of an employee who tests positive on a single drug test. It states that such a dismissal to be exempt from due process procedures. The bill clarifies that its provisions do not apply to a positive test for marijuana if the employee is a patient licensed by the OMMA.
