Fiscal Analysis

SB 505 allows DHS to seek a waiver to provide SNAP benefits to able-bodied adults without dependents if they reside in an area with an unemployment rate over 10%. SNAP is fully funded by the federal government with a small portion of state dollars funding its administration. The most recent USDA data show that no county is currently at this threshold.
