PROPOSAL: New Law

Engrossed SB 595 proposes to allow the Oklahoma Tax Commission (OTC) to enter into a contract with any state agency and charge a fee to assist in the collection of any state tax, penalties or interest in which that agency has the authority to collect and enforce. The fee charged by the OTC may not exceed 10% of the total amount actually collected. Under this proposal, the OTC may enter into a contract with the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission (OESC) whereby the OTC is authorized to collect and enforce any delinquent unemployment tax, penalties or interest that the OESC is entitled to collect. All funds retained by the OTC for collections services are deposited in the Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund of the State Treasury.
