Engrossed SB 596 amends 68 O.S. § 227, which relates to a taxpayer's claim for refund, and § 1361.2, which relates to the state sales tax exemption for certain disabled veterans. To claim a refund of sales taxes erroneously paid, an eligible taxpayer must submit to the Tax Commission a signed notification of the vendor's denial of the sales tax exemption for 100% disabled veterans.
