PROPOSAL: Amendatory

Section 44 of the measure proposes to amend 47 O.S. § 230.9 by allowing the Department of Public Safety in order to recover administrative penalties imposed by the Commissioner of Public Safety against persons violating recordkeeping, safety or other provisions of the Oklahoma Motor Carrier Safety and Hazardous Materials Transportation Act to file an itemization of unpaid administrative penalties, fees, and charges with the Oklahoma Tax Commission for collection at the time of the vehicle's registration. It further provides that OTC shall not issue or renew a vehicle's registration upon receipt of an itemization of unpaid administrative penalties, fees, and charges from the Department of Public Safety until paid.

Revenue Impact
