**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 648 sets the maximum imprisonment term for persons convicted of maliciously inciting or producing violence which is likely to result in imminent violence, injury, or death to a law enforcement officer, emergency first responder, member of the Oklahoma National Guard, or any unit of the armed services solely because of that person's employment, to life without parole. This bill could result in an increase in Oklahoma's incarcerated population, however the fiscal impact is contingent on the number of people convicted of the offenses listed in the bill. Average daily cost per inmate for maximum, medium, and minimum security is \$108.17, \$61.71, and \$57.39 respectively.
