Fiscal Analysis

SB 670 creates a felony for selling or possessing certain controlled dangerous substances within 1,000 feet of a school. The bill also provides for certain circumstances in which the provisions do not apply. This bill could result in an increase in Oklahoma's incarcerated population, however the fiscal impact is contingent on the number of people convicted of the offenses listed in the bill. Average daily cost per inmate for maximum, medium, and minimum security is \$108.17, \$61.71, and \$57.39 respectively.
