**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 749 would create a \$0.01 fee per kilowatt of total nameplate generating capacity for commercial wind equipment. Although Corporation Commission estimates this would generate \$90,000 to be deposited into the Education Reform (1017) Fund, the cost to the agency to implement the bill would far exceed that amount. Besides the cost for a reporting and collection software system, and the estimated rulemaking cost of \$25,000 to \$50,000, OCC also states the need of 1.5 FTE to administer which would be in excess of \$100,000 with benefits included.
