Re: Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 1188 RBS No. 3619

Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 1188 would allow a participant of Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement System to be employed by a city as a police officer provided the city's population is 4500 or less. Such participant would not receive additional service or have benefits suspended.

The bill would allow cities with population of 4500 or less to employ persons as police officers and not become participants in OPPRS.

This bill is a non fiscal bill under OPLAAA.
