Re: Proposed Committee substitute for House Bill No. 2686 RBH No. 10766

House Bill No. 2686 would reduce the vesting service requirement for Oklahoma Teachers Retirement System to 5 years from 7 years.

This bill would increase the unfunded actuarial accrued liability by \$2,000,000 and increase the normal cost by .02% according to GRS the system's actuarial firm.

This bill will not increase the number of years until the system is fully funded(17).

This bill currently effects about 25% of the participants. As the current participants retire and are replaced by new participants who become a larger portion the participants the normal cost will increase.

The bill appropriates \$2,000,000 to OTRS to fully fund the increase in accrued liability.
