This would allow a retired firefighter to serve as Fire Chief of a city with population under 20,000. The firefighter would not receive any additional benefits from such service nor be eligible any disability benefits.

The city and fire chief will make contributions to the System if the fire chief does not have 30 years of service.

This bill is a non fiscal bill under OPLAAA.
